## Dance Descriptions

CW = clockwise / CCW = counter-clockwise
$M=$ man or men $/ W=$ woman or women
M1 = first man $/ M 2=$ second man
W1 = first woman / W2 = second woman
$1 s, 2 s, 3 s=$ first couple, second couple, third couple
In a three-couple set,
couples retain their number throughout a repetition,
regardless of their position in the set.
At the start of a new repetition
couples acquire new numbers.

## Barbarini's Tambourine 1745-1755

INTERMEDIATE: Longways Duple Minor
A1 1-8 1st corners cast left into a half figure eight through the 2nd corners
(go CCW around neighbor, pass each other by left in the center, go CW around partner), ending in each other's place.

A2 1-8 2 nd corners cast right into a half figure eight through the 1st corners (go CW around partner [in neighbor's home place], pass each other by right in the center, go CCW around neighbor [in partner's home place]), ending in each other's place.

B1 1-4 Facing partner, fall back a double, come forward and cross over.

5-8 Neighbor back-to-back.
9-12 Partner back-to-back.

B2 1-8 Four changes rights and lefts starting with partner.
9-12 Partner two-hand turn once around.

## Come Let's Be Merry ca1726-1755

EASY: Longways 3 Couple Set
A1 $\quad 1-4 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ face up (joining nearest hands) and wheel around, then honor the 2 s .
5-8 Repeat.

A2 $\quad 1-4 \quad 1$ s face up and cast down into 2 nd place while 2 s meet and lead up.
5-8 1s cast to the bottom while 3 s meet and lead up.

B 1-8 1s dance up the center to the top, then cast to the middle, 3 s moving down.

9-14 Hands six: Balance in-and-out three times while circling left halfway.
15-16 Partners two-hand turn halfway.
Ends 3-1-2.
Repeat with new top couple.

## Braes of Dornoch ca1753-1755

INTERMEDIATE: Longways 3 Couple Set
A 1-4 1s lead down the center to the bottom, then cast up to middle place ( 2 s move up).
5-8 1s two-hand turn once around.
9-12 1 s lead up through $2 s$ and cast down to middle.
13-16 1s two-hand turn three-quarters around, then acknowledge each other and turn their backs to each other [turning to the right], forming wavy lines-of-three with the nearest end couple [W up with $2 s, M$ down with 3s].

B 1-2 All balance forward and back.
3-8 Wavy-line neighbors left hand turn [opposite gender] once around, then right hand turn [same gender] three-quarters around, ending with $1 s$ proper in middle place.
9-12 Partners back-to-back [everyone].
13-16 Bottom two couples [ones and threes] three changes rights and lefts (with hands) while the top couple [2s] two-hand turn once around.
Ends 2-3-1. Repeat with new top couple.

## The Comical Fellow 1776

EASY: Longways Duple Minor
A1 1-8 M1 set forward toward W2, fall back to place, then 1st corners two-hand turn.

A2 1-8 W1 set forward toward M2, fall back to place, then 2nd corners two-hand turn.

B1 1-8 1s lead down the center, return to place skipping, then cast down into 2nd place (2s move up).
9-12 All clap four times, then partners two-hand turn halfway.

B2 1-8 Same four circle left and right.
9-12 All clap four times, then partners two-hand turn halfway.

## Drapers Gardens 1706-1760

EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-8 1st corners set, turn single, and two-hand turn once around.

A2 1-8 2 nd corners set, turn single, and two-hand turn once around.

B $\quad$ 1-4 $\quad$ W two-hand turn halfway, then M two-hand turn halfway.

5-8 Circle (four) left halfway and fall back into lines.
9-12 Two changes rights and lefts starting with partner.

13-16 1 s lead up through the 2 s and cast down to progressed place.

## Flora and Phaon 1718-1760

EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-2 Circle left halfway
3-4 Facing partners (neighbors retaining hands), all set in place.

A2 1-2 Circle left halfway
3-4 All turn single up ( $M$ left, W right).

B1 1-2 1s cast down while $2 s$ meet and lead up
3-4 Partners [everyone] two-hand turn once around.

B2 1-2 2s cast down and lead up while 1s lead up and cast down [this is quick]
3-4 All turn single towards new neighbors (1s down, 2 s up)

## The Duke of Kent's Waltz 1801

EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-8 Right hand star and left hand star.

A2 $\quad 1-4 \quad 1 s$ do two side-steps down the center and two side-steps up the center.

5-8 1s balance and cast down to 2nd place (2s move up).

B $\quad$ 1-4 Partners right-hand balance and trade places with the W turning under.

5-8 Partners left-hand balance and trade places with the $W$ turning under.

9-12 On the right diagonal (those who can) right hand turn once around.

13-16 Partners left hand turn once around.

## The Geud Man of Ballangigh 1696-1755

EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-4 1 s lead down through $2 s$ and cast up to place.
5-8 M lead through the W (between their partners) and cast to place.

A2 1-4 2 s lead up through 1 s and cast down to place.
5-8 W lead through the $M$ (between their partners) and cast to place.

B1 1-4 1st corners set towards each other and turn single back to place.
5-8 2nd corners set towards each other and turn single back to place.

B2 1-2 Circle left halfway.
3-4 Neighbors fall back from partner.
5-6 All come forward, setting.
7-8 Partners trade places by right shoulder.

Irish Lamentation ca1740-1755
INTERMEDIATE: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-4 Take hands four and all "step-set" left and right twice.

5-8 1st corners two-hand turn.
A2 1-4 Take hands four and all "step-set" left and right twice.
5-8 2nd corners two-hand turn.
B1 1-2 Partners face up (joining nearest hands), dance up the set, then turn to face out.
3-4 Neighbors take nearest hands and 2 s gate the 1 s down into second place ( 2 s back up).

5-6 Partners face down (joining nearest hands), dance down the set, then turn to face out.
7-8 Neighbors take nearest hands and 2 s gate the 1 s up into original place ( 2 s back up).

9-16 1 s cross right and go below ( 2 s move up), then half figure eight up thru the 2 s .
B2 1-8 Four changes rights and lefts starting with partner.
9-16 Partners waltz or promenade CCW around the other couple, ending progressed and proper.

## Mr. Beveridge's Maggot 1695-1728

ADVANCED: Longways Duple Minor
Note: there are different versions of this dance in circulation. This is Cecil Sharp's reconstruction in which the B music is played twice.

A1 1-2 1s cross to trade places, falling back on the last three steps.
3-4 Neighbor back-to-back.
A2 $1 \quad 1$ s turn single right.
2-3 Neighbor right hand turn once around.
4 1s left hand turn halfway, ending at home.
B1 1-2 1 s cross and go below while $2 s$ meet and lead up.

3-4 Partners back-to-back, ending with 1 s in the middle of a line of four facing up.
5-7 Line of four lead up (six steps) and fall back (three steps).
$8 \quad 2 s$ assist the $1 s$ to finish above the $2 s$ ( 1 s improper, 2 s proper).
B2 1-6 1s full figure eight down thru the $2 s$, skipping.
7-8 1 s cross right and go below ( $2 s$ move up).

## Knole Park 1791-1809

EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-4 Circle left once around.
5-8 1st corners trade places by right, then 2 nd corners trade places by right.

A2 $\quad$ 1-4 Circle left once around from here.
5-8 1st corners trade places by right, then 2 nd corners trade places by right.

B1 1-8 1s lead down the center, return to place skipping, then cast down (2s move up).

B2 1-8 Partners full poussette CCW (starting M1 go forward, M2 back up).

Money in Both Pockets 1794
EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-4 1 s , with nearest hands joined, set twice to W2.
5-8 Same three circle left once around.

A2 $\quad 1-4 \quad 1 s$, with nearest hands joined, set twice to $M 2$.
5-8 Same three circle left once around.

B1 1-8 1s lead down the center, turn and lead up, then cast into 2 nd place ( 2 s move up).

B2 1-8 Four changes rights and lefts starting with partner.

## Prince William 1731-1760

## ADVANCED: Longways 3 Couple Set

A1 1-8 Crossover mirror hey-for-three, starting 1 s cross down thru middle place to opposite sides, $2 s$ separate up around the $1 s$, and $3 s$ lead up from the bottom between the 1s. Each couple enters thru the ends and separates out the middle. The figure ends in original places, but with 1 s improper.

A2 1-8 Repeat, with 1 s crossing thru middle to proper sides, ending all home.

B1 1-4 1s cross right and go below into middle place (2s move up).

5-8 1s two-hand turn once-and-a-half to proper sides.
B2 1-4 2 s cross right and go below into middle place (1s move up).

5-8 2 s two-hand turn once-and-a-half to proper sides.
A3 1-4 1st country corners right hand turn (M1 goes to W3, W1 goes to M2).

5-8 1 s left hand turn in the center.

A4 1-4 2 nd country corners right hand turn (M1 with W2, W1 with M3).

5-8 1 s left hand turn in the center, and end facing the W's line with W1 on the right.

B3 1-4 1s lead thru the W , separate and cast to the middle.
5-8 1s two-hand turn once-and-a-half to face the M's line with W1 on the right.

B4 1-4 1s lead through the M, separate and cast to the middle.
5-8 1s two-hand turn, spiraling to the bottom (ending proper) while the 3 s move up the outside.

Ends 2-3-1. Repeat with new top couple.

## Softly Good Tummas 1718-1755

## ADVANCED: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-4 Circle left single file halfway around ["two doubles"].
5-6 All meet in the center.
7-8 All turn single left out to place, clapping on the last beat.

A2 1-4 Circle right single file halfway around
["two doubles"].
5-6 All meet in the center,
7-8 All turn single right out to place, clapping on the last beat [all now home].

B1 1-2 1 s quick cast down (2s move up).
3-4 All set to partner.
5-8 Two changes rights and lefts (with hands) starting with partner.

B2 1-2 Facing partner (across), fall back setting.
3-4 Partners cross over (right shoulder)
and turn right to face,
5-8 1 s right hand turn once around, spiraling down into second place, while $2 s$ wide cast up into first place.

## A Trip to Tunbridge 1793

EASY: Longways 3 Couple Set

A1 1-8 1s cast down the outside, acknowledge partner, then come up the outside to place.

A2 1-8 1s lead down the center, return to place skipping, then cast down into 2 nd place ( 2 s move up).

B1 1-4 1s pass right, then first corners (right diag.) right hand turn.

5-8 1s pass right, then second corners (left diag.) right hand turn.

B2 1-4 1s pass right, then lead own line out to the wall and fall back.

5-8 Partners two-hand turn, ending with 1 s casting to the bottom (3s moving up).
Ends 2-3-1. Repeat with new top couple.

## Zephyrs and Flora 1715-1728

EASY: Longways Duple Minor

A1 1-4 1st corners back-to-back.
5-8 1st corners take right hands,
then take left hands,
then turn halfway to trade places.

A2 1-4 2nd corners back-to-back.
5-8 2nd corners take right hands, then left hands, then turn halfway to trade places.

B1 1-4 1s cast up (2s move down).
5-8 $1 s$ half figure eight down thru the $2 s$.

B2 1-4 2 s cast up (1s move down).
5-8 $2 s$ half figure eight down thru the 1 s .
